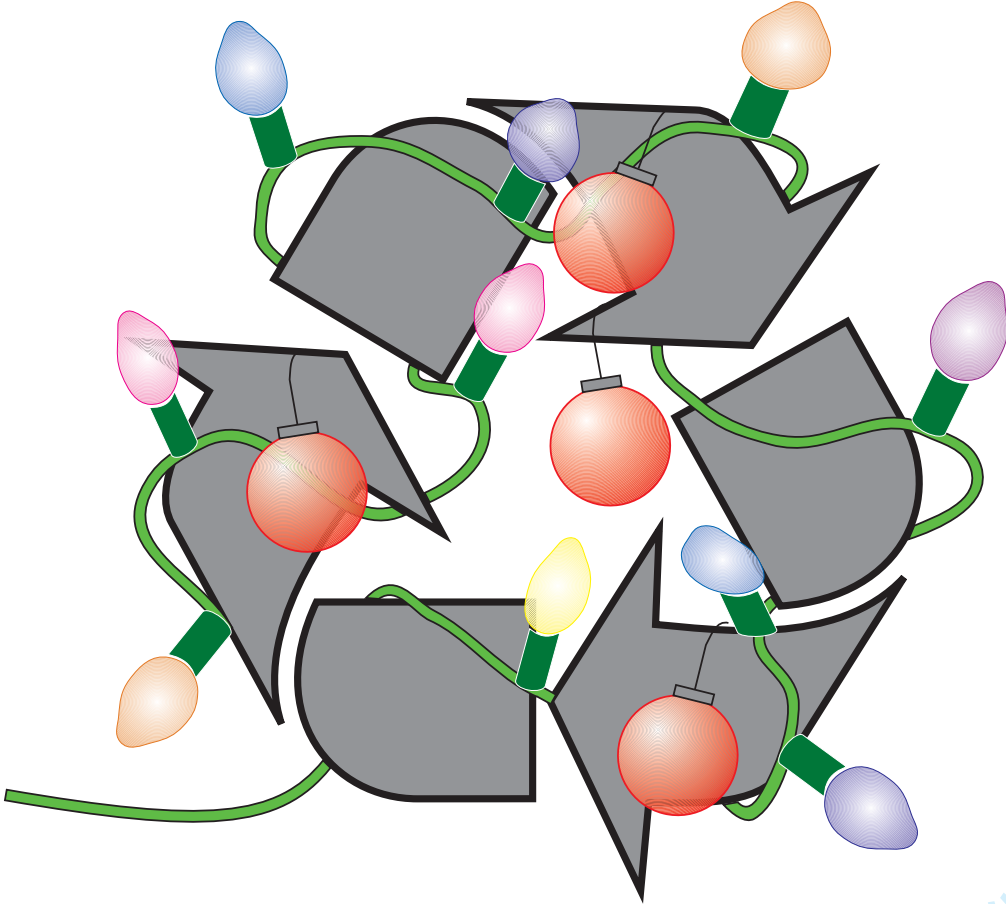

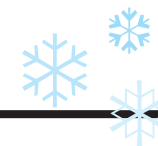

Highway 370 between I-80 and 168th Street. Wildlife Management Area south parking lot.

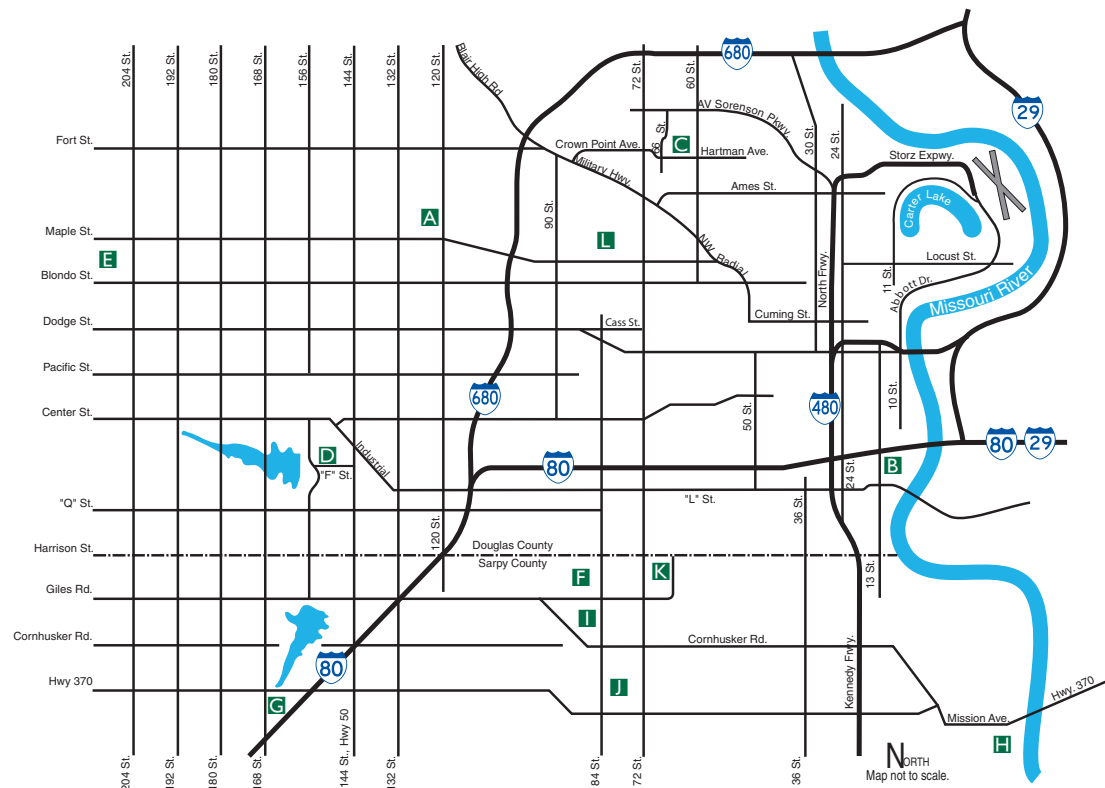
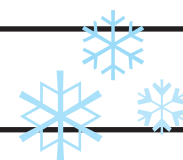
- H** Bellevue Old Sarpy County Landfill

[‡] At many sites, there will be volunteers to help you unload your tree during the dates and times noted. If you drop off your tree at another time or at a site that does not have volunteers helping, please throw your tree up on the pile. This will leave room for others to access the site.
